#### **Tournament Rules:**

WKF standard rules with Karate Canada modifications as applied at "Karate Canada Nationals".

Equipment: As per KC standards.

- o Kumite compulsory equipment:
  - o Gloves (red, blue)
  - o Competition belts (red, blue)
  - o Shinguards & insteps (red, blue or "white")
  - Mouthguard
  - o Groin protectors compulsory for "males".
  - Red must wear that colour *gloves*, *belt* and if wearing coloured *shinguards* & *insteps* they too must be red.

Blue must wear that colour *gloves*, *belt* and if wearing coloured *shinguards* & *insteps* they too must be blue.

White shinguards/instep protectors are acceptable for either Red or Blue.

- Chestguards only the WKF "interior" chestguards are permitted.
   NO exterior (outside the gi) chestguards.
- Face-masks of the WKF standard required for 14-15yrs old these are optional.
- o NO helmets with or without cages/masks.
- o NO eyeglasses for kumite. Protective eyewear is permitted.
- o Kata eyeglasses are permitted for kata only.

#### Kumite Match Duration:

- o Under 18 yrs all divisions 2 minutes "stopped time".
- o 18 yrs blackbelt divisions (or KC National level competitors 18yrs +) as per WKF standards.

## Repechage

- o Kumite All matches will be elimination with "repechage".
- Kata All matches will be with "flags" and there will be elimination with "repechage".

## Kata - Choice of kata.

- Athletes aspiring or already chosen to compete at the KC Nationals, must choose a different kata for each round and repechage. No repetition of a kata once it is performed.
- All other athletes may repeat any kata in any round if they so choose.

Awards will be Medals for 1st (gold), 2nd (silver), 3rd place/tie (2 bronze).

### Transportation - land:

Airport to Hotel is responsibility of the visiting athletes/teams.

Transportation from Hotel to Venue and return - Karate NL will investigate possibility of chartered transport, however a minimal charge will be required; more information will be available once we have a better idea of "how many visitors" will need transportation assistance.
